#### 1. All racial and economic achievement gaps between students is closed

BGCS will increase the percent of all students who "meet standard" on the MCA exams and NWEA exams each year as evidence of closing the racial and economic achievement gap. (Note: BGCS does not have a very diverse population and has cell size too small to report) **Measure**: MCA exams (internal use if cell size is too small) and NWEA exams (public

reporting limited to small sample size).

#### 2. <u>All children are ready for school</u>

BGCS will increase the percent of children who are ready for school each year. **Measure:** Birch Grove Community School will continue to offer the Saplings Program (licensed daycare run as a pre-school) for children ages 3-5. BGCS will measure school readiness with fall NWEA assessments. (Note: BGCS will use NWEA internally as cell size is too small to report) **Reporting:** School Annual Report (MS. 124d.10)

#### 3. All third-graders can read at grade level

School will increase the percent of all third graders that can read at grade level each year based on state standards and NWEA exams. Measure: MCA exams (internal use) and NWEA exams (public reporting limited due to low sample size). Reporting: School Annual Report (MS. 124d.10)
